


By Automobile to Istria ...


Travelling from Germany or Austria to Croatia

By automobile to the Istrian peninsula

Who wants to be mobile while in vacation in Croatia, that is in Istria, but not be dependant on renting a car, needs to travel by automobile. Ordinarily from Germany you travel through Salzburg and Villach, that is, the Tauern motor-road towards Slovenia. From here you travel in the direction towards Ljubljana and Postojna, and then over the Slovenian-Croatian border.

Your travel to Svetvinčenat/Smoljanci

Germany: Munich (BAB A8, direction Salzburg) – Rosenheim – border crossing Salzburg 

Austria: triangle motor-road Salzburg, direction Villach – Radstadt – Spittal – intersection motor-road Villach, direction Ljubljana – border crossing tunnel Karavanka 

Slovenija: Kranj – Ljubljana – Postojna – direction Gracišće – border crossing Socerga/Buzet 

Croatia/Istra: Socerga/Buzet: direction Rijeka – Buzet – Roc – in Lupoglava drive on the fast road in the direction of Pula: - Pazin – at the turn off “Žminj” exit the fast road – at the entrance to the main road turn left towards Žminj – at the next intersection turn right, direction Pula (on the right side you will see a petrol station) – Ferlina – after the sign with Svetvinčenat on it: follow right direction Smoljanci (yellow sign-post), after 3 km you will arrive at a sign Smoljanci – the third house on the left belongs to the estate “Stancija 1904”. In front of the railway crossing you will see a wooden sign “Agrotourism Stancija 1904”, where you make a left hand turn onto the entrance...you are now on the parking area of “Stancija 1904”
